Photo and Video Tips

- Ask permission before photographing anyone, especially the neighbors where you are serving and children. If you need a generic photo release form, you can find one [here](#).
- Show your volunteers at work and at the place where you are serving.
- Treat everyone with dignity.
- Natural light and a steady phone are all you need.
- A short clip of 10 to 15 seconds with a few words on screen will reach more people than a long one.



What to Post During the Week

You do not need to post every day. Even two or three posts tell your story well. Some examples are: show your team preparing, a moment from your service project, a volunteer's brief reflection, a moment from Sunday worship, and/or a thank-you afterward.
