## CONGREGATIONAL TIPS FOR THE DAY OF VOLUNTEERING AND SERVICE

### Congregational Quick-Start Guide for Volunteer Event

1. Appoint a Congregational Lead plus 2–3 team members.
2. Pick a volunteer/service project for the day.
3. Set simple goals (e.g., “50 volunteers; 200 hygiene kits”).
4. Tell DHM about your plans for the day [here](#).
5. Recruit volunteers.
6. Use social media kit for promotion.
7. Arrange supplies & define roles. Consider recommendations below.
8. Tell your story: assign a photo/videographer and storyteller lead for the day.
9. After the event, submit your video/photos/stories to DHM to share your volunteering stories [here](#).
10. Celebrate volunteers on Sunday with the free, downloadable resources [here](#).
11. Keep shining God’s light through your mission and outreach efforts!
